

**You will need:**

- Playing pieces (you can use a small piece of paper labeled with your name)
- Six small pieces of paper, numbered 1 to 6

**To play:**

- Decide which player goes first: Put the numbered pieces in a pile. Close your eyes and draw a number from the pile. The player with the highest number goes first.
- For each turn, close your eyes and draw a number from the pile. Move your playing piece forward the number of spaces indicated on the paper. Follow the directions on the space you land on.
- The first one to the schoolhouse wins. (Watch out for mud tracks!)



Pick flowers for the teacher.

Walk faster or you'll be late!

Help friend avoid the mud. Move ahead 2 spaces.

Played too long in grass. Go back 2 spaces.

School building in sight!

Dropped your books in the muck! Yuck! Lose a turn.

Step around muddy spots. Move ahead 2 spaces.

Cross street at crosswalk. Move ahead 2 spaces.

Slipped in the sludge. Lose a turn.

Left backpack at swamp. Go back 3 spaces.

No more mud! You're almost there!

Stop at store for soap.

Help Little Frog. Move ahead 3 spaces.
